DIEBOLD LAUNCHES SUITE OF COMPREHENSIVE IDENTITY AND ACCESS MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS

CredentialOneSM brings holistic approach to creation and practical use of credentials

NORTH CANTON, Ohio – As identity theft and fraud become more pervasive in our society, security strategies must evolve to a new level of sophistication. That’s why Diebold, Incorporated (NYSE: DBD) is introducing CredentialOneSM, a new, innovative suite of comprehensive identity and access management solutions.

CredentialOne is a holistic approach to the creation and practical usage of credentials to ensure the security of people, facilities and assets. The suite of solutions, which is the most robust in the industry, enables the creation of a system and infrastructure to establish personal identity, manage credential issuance and usage, and provide for authenticated access to facilities and information assets.

“At its most fundamental, Diebold believes security encompasses the ability to identify the individuals who enter facilities, access physical property and leverage logical assets,” said Dennis M. Moriarty, senior vice president, Diebold Security. “Modern tools must enable organizations to not only verify who people are, but also to manage their access to property and corporate assets. Simply requiring the presentation of an identification card at a facility’s entrance is no longer enough. That’s why we believe CredentialOne is so critical to every market we serve. And we believe our expertise, integration capabilities and service culture make us uniquely qualified to deliver these sophisticated solutions to our customers.”

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Based on a single enrollment process that enables the provisioning and de-provisioning of systems and applications, CredentialOne captures data from either an existing smart card or authoritative database, or by following a defined process that includes enrollment, vetting, personalization and issuance. The suite is scalable via technology based on open standards and an identity integration framework that establishes an integrated, interoperable, secure credential and access management environment.

Because CredentialOne includes a provisioning capability, it helps ensure each participant maintains only one identity. This results in uniform implementation of the identity, simultaneous distribution of on-boarding instructions and off-boarding and more efficient communications among various systems and departments across organizations or departments. It also eliminates the disparate documentation and procedures that often lead to gaps in an organization's protection measures and, ultimately, breaches in security. Diebold's identity and access management experts can help customers navigate the complexities of selecting and implementing such a solution.

"The implementation of an identity and access management strategy requires a deep understanding of the discipline, as well as an unprecedented level of cooperation among organizations' human resources, information technology and security departments," said Tony Damalas, vice president, technology, Diebold Security. Once a universal credential has been issued, CredentialOne enables customers to leverage the investment to enable usage. The single, unique credential can be used for physical access control (PACS), logical access control (LACS) and single sign-on (SSO).

PACS grants participants access to physical assets, including facilities, rooms within facilities, documents, supplies and more. It can include a variety of applications, including visitor management and access tracking. Credentials can also be used for LACS, governing access to an organization's wealth of data and information assets. LACS can include computer or network logon, access to digital assets and more. And the credential can even be used to enable SSO, allowing users to complete a single login to gain access to multiple resources, applications and software systems. SSO can help minimize password vulnerabilities and can result in efficiencies throughout an organization's data warehouse.

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CredentialOne was developed to meet even the most stringent identity and access management requirements, such as those of the government market. Government agencies are currently working to ensure compliance with the 12th Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD-12), which calls for a common identification standard for federal employees and contractors. The Diebold solution meets the Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS 201) that outline a specific approach for compliance with HSPD-12, requiring the issuance of a common identification credential that is interoperable and can also be used for applications such as PACS and LACS.

Diebold is approved and listed as a qualified HSPD-12 security integrator by the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) and is one of a limited number of security integrators to be certified to provide partial or complete turnkey, end-to-end solutions that enable compliance with HSPD-12 and FIPS 201. Diebold also participates and is actively involved with independent and industry organizations that have helped shape FIPS 201, such as the Smart Card Alliance Physical Access and Identity Councils and the Security Industry Association.

“Because Diebold has a history in physical security, a modern approach that also includes logical security expertise and a role in industry associations driving identity management standards, we can deliver solutions such as CredentialOne,” Moriarty said. “This suite of solutions can help our customers build an infrastructure that includes forward-thinking processes and components not only for establishing personal identity and managing credential issuance, but also for leveraging the investment in the credential to deliver usage through automated provisioning and access management.
