Additional Information about Staying in Kampala

- Transport /Airport: A taxi hire will cost 50,000/= each way. This is approximately 25\$ x2.
- Hotels - we recommend staying on the side of town closest to the training facility. Below are a few options:
 - ARA (American Recreation Association); they have a swimming pool, small gym, bar, pool table, TVs, movie library, etc. The rate is 65 - 75\$ per person and includes a continental breakfast. The rate, if sharing, is 50\$ per person per night.
 - Hospice Guesthouse is 15\$ per night and includes breakfast and dinner. Bathrooms are communal (sharing).
 - Calendar Hotel is 20\$ per night and includes breakfast. Private rooms with ensuite bathrooms.
- Meals - The above, will provide you with a continental breakfast. We provide tea, coffee, and lunch. That leaves dinner; option b provides dinner in the package. However, you can eat at a number of restaurants nearby and 10\$ per day should cover you.
- Car Rental:
 - City Cars (www.DriveUganda.com) - approx \$100.00 per day plus 18% VAT. Price includes a driver to take you around in the evenings. I believe it is 80.00\$ plus VAT without a driver.
 - An alternative would be to hire one of our training vehicles (Landrover Defenders) for the course, at a rate of 65.00\$ per day /plus VAT and hire a taxi in the evenings to get around, if needed. Limited number available, so these need to be booked early. The vehicle is only available during training hours.
- Currency - Please bring crisp clean bills issued after 2001. Exact change means waiting less time for the clerk to issue a visa; getting change can be a very long process. Also, bills issued before 1996 are generally not accepted in most shops and forex bureaus due to counterfeit /machine readability problems here. Also, bills that are not in crisp condition sometimes have problems being read by the machines and again can result in being rejected. Finally, if possible and with the exception of buying a Visa, bring 50 /100\$ bills. Any currency denomination less than 50\$ gets exchanged at a significantly lower rate than the larger bills. Go figure. No other currency has these problems.
- Passports - Passports are required to enter Uganda.
